### What to Wear

- \* Fitted Collared Top tucked in to you breeches
- \* Winter - a fitted vest or jacket
- \* Breeches & Belt
- \* Half Chaps & Paddock Boots or Field Boots
- \* ASTM / SEI Approved Riding Helmet
- \* Riding Gloves & Crop

## Winter Attire



Hair should be tied back neatly, with no pieces hanging out.

Hair can be tucked up in your helmet, or hanging down in a tidy pony tail at the base of your neck.

### What not to Wear

- Loose fitting clothing - makes it hard for the instructor to see body position
- Hoodies or Hooded Jackets
- Low cut shirts
- Unclean clothing & apparel
- Clothing/apparel that is not appropriate for the season
