GENERAL INFORMATION

Regular camp hours are from 9am to 4pm. Extended hours are available from 8am to 5:30pm, at a fee of \$45.00 per week. Prior arrangements must be made for the use of the extended hours.

If your child is unable to attend camp for any reason, please call or e-mail the barn so we know not to expect them.

Campers need to bring their own lunch, we do have vending machines for snacks and beverages. Due to the frequency of peanut related allergies, we ask that campers not bring peanut butter or peanut products in their lunches.

*Please be advised that once campers are registered, there will be an administration fee of \$50.00 to withdraw from the program. Refunds less the administration fee will only be issued if cancellations are done a minimum of 8 days prior to the first day of camp.
No refunds will be issued within 7 days of the start of camp.*

Please note: week changes or cancellations must also be done a minimum of 8 days prior to the first day of camp.

CLOTHING

REMEMBER TO DRESS WARMLY!!! Layer, layer, layer!

Safety helmets, crops and footwear designed for riding are mandatory, and may be rented from the stables.

Meadowlarke Stables offers rental of the following size ranges for helmets & boots:

Helmets - 6 5/8 - 7 3/8 (metric 20 1/2 - 23 1/8) Boots - Children's 12 - Men's 11 (metric 30-44)

If you do not fit or are uncertain if you fit this size range, please advise the office upon registration.

Riding breeches are recommended as they are designed for riding, if you do not have breeches comfortable pants such as leggings or track pants may be worn. Jeans are not recommended as they have no stretch, and the seam can be uncomfortable. Campers may bring shorts and running shoes to wear when they are not riding. *No Sandals or Crocs* at any time please. Riding gloves are recommended. The Equine Emporium is located next to the stables and offers a complete line of clothing for anyone wishing to purchase their own.

Learn to Ride, Early Start & Camp Registrants

Safety Riding Helmets and Riding Boots are mandatory to participate in a program.

Meadowlarke Stables reserves the right to not offer lessons to those persons who they feel will be detrimental to the horses well being due, to their height, balance and/or weight

All personal tack that is planned for use on Meadowlarke Stables horses must first be approved by Meadowlarke Stables to determine it's comfort & suitability to our horses and the rider.

Any un-approved tack may not be used.

Notification of schedule changes, due to holidays, 5th weeks and horse shows, are posted on our website - www.south.meadowlarkestables.com ('Calendar of Events' under the Resources tab), it is your responsibility to be aware of these changes.

Class Dates

**If you are unable to attend a class, there are no make-ups available. Any missed classes are forfeited. Please check the dates prior to registration.

Withdrawing from a Program

** Cancellation from the Learn to Ride Program or Camp may be done up to 8 days prior to the start date.

** Cancellation from the Early Start Program may be done up to 8 days prior to the start of the month.

** At this point your registration fees will be refunded less a \$50.00 administration fee

No refunds are available within 7 days of the start of the program/month
