

Competition Attire & Horse Turnout

Though riders do not need to have the full "Competition Attire", they do need to be neatly turned out.

Please remember this is a subjectively judged sport - turnout of horse and rider will count in their overall placing.

Extra attention to detail should be paid.

Tack should be Cleaned thoroughly

A White Fitted saddle pad is most appropriate

(unless your horse is required to wear a special pad)

Bits should be wiped down and clean



Horses should be thoroughly groomed

Tails should be brushed out preferably with a detangler like Showsheen

Spot removers / Dry Shampoos can be purchased for light coloured horses

Whether you have full Competition Attire or you are turning out in Schooling Attire, you should always be neatly put together.

Here are our tips!



Schooling Attire

- * Dark helmet or helmet cover with hair neatly pulled back in a hair net
- * Fitted subtle coloured shirt with a collar
- * Dark Gloves
- * Black Show Bat
- * Classic Belt
- * Beige or light coloured Breeches
- * Feld Boots or Half Chaps & Paddock Boots

Schooling, North Series & 'A' Circuit Attire

- * Dark non-plastic helmet with hair neatly pulled back in a hair net
- * Fitted Competition Jacket w/ complimenting competition shirt
- * Dark Gloves
- * Black Show Bat
- * Classic Belt
- * Beige Breeches
- * Field Boots
