## MARCH BREAK CAMP POLICIES AND INFORMATION

### CAMP HOURS AND ATTENDANCE

Regular camp hours are from 9am to 4pm. Extended hours are available from 8am to 5:30pm, at a fee of \$45.00 per week. Prior arrangements must be made for the use of the extended hours. Please note that late pickups are charged at a rate of \$15 per 15 minutes late or part thereof; charges start at 4.15pm for children on regular hours or 5.30pm for children on extended hours.

If your child is unable to attend camp, please call or e-mail the barn so we know not to expect them.

### FOOD AND BEVERAGES

All campers need to bring their own beverages, snacks and lunches from home when coming to camp. Due to the frequency of peanut related allergies, we ask that campers not bring peanut products in their lunches. Please do not arrange fast food delivery as we are not in a position to receive and deliver food orders to your children.

### WITHDRAWAL

Please be advised that once campers are registered, there will be an administration fee of \$50.00 to withdraw from the program. Refunds less the administration fee will only be issued if cancellations are done a minimum of 8 days prior to the first day of camp. No refunds will be issued within 7 days of the start of camp.

**Meadowlarke Stables reserves the right to not offer our camp program to those persons who they feel will be detrimental to the horses well being due, to their height, balance and/or weight**

For safety reasons Meadowlarke Stables Inc. reserves the right to suspend participants, if they or their associates do not follow staff instructions. No refunds will be given in this case.

### CLOTHING AND PERSONAL BELONGINGS

REMEMBER TO DRESS WARMLY!!! Layer, layer, layer!

Safety helmets, crops and footwear designed for riding are mandatory, and may be rented from the stables.

Meadowlarke Stables offers rental of the following size ranges for helmets & boots:

Helmets - 6 5/8 - 7 3/8 ( metric 20 1/2 - 23 1/8 ) Boots - Children's 12 - Men's 11 ( metric 30-44 )

If you do not fit or are uncertain if you fit this size range, please advise the office upon registration.

Riding breeches are recommended as they are designed for riding, if you do not have breeches comfortable pants such as leggings or track pants may be worn. Jeans are not recommended as they have minimal stretch, and the seam can be uncomfortable. Campers may wear their own winter boots or running shoes when they are not riding. **No Sandals or Crocs** at any time please. Riding gloves are recommended, mittens are not recommended. The Equine Emporium is located next to the stables and offers a complete line of clothing for anyone wishing to purchase their own.

It is advisable to label all belongings, and campers are encouraged to leave valuables at home.
